PROTOCOL IN INNER WHEEL

What is Protocol?

In our everyday life, we follow a certain code of conduct on how to behave, speak, sit or stand, how we need to behave at home, our workplace, with our children or friends or in formal functions.

Similarly, in Organisations also we need to follow a set of rules to help maintain the grace, beauty, dignity and order of our Organisation, ourselves as well as with our colleagues and friends.

Protocol in Inner Wheel means formal etiquettes, Procedure, Principles, Moral Codes and Rules for Meetings and Formal Functions.

They are the code of behaviour and set of courtesies. They add grace, beauty, dignity and order to our functioning.

Protocol needs to be observed in Inner Wheel at all levels – Club, District, National and International.

PROTOCOL AT CLUB LEVEL:

In Salutations / In Addressing Dignitaries

- Club President is the CEO in Club.
- To be addressed FIRST in Meetings & Club Functions & Events, followed by current Club Officers, District Post holders, Past District Chairmen and Members

During District Chairman's Official Visit to the Club:

- First Address Club President
- National President, if Present (she is addressed after DC as DC is Chief Guest in the Official Visit to the Club)
- District Chairman
- All Current District Officers, if any
- Future Officers, if any
- Past District Chairmen
- Rotary District Governor, if Present

At Club Level

- President is CEO of Club
- President always sits in the centre on the dais
- She must wear the Collar & is Addressed first
- All others, including DC / Chief Guest, to be addressed after the Club President
- If National President is present, she is addressed after the Club President, followed by District Chairman
- If IIW President or Vice President is present, she is addressed first, after Club President, followed by National President and DC
- President receives the District Chairman
- If National or IIW President is visiting a Club, President & District Chairman should receive them
- Similarly, Club President & District Chairman should see them off
- At Club's Official Visit, District Chairman is Chief Guest.
- If any other dignitary is invited during DC's OCV, they may be present only during the Inaugural Function. Not in Business Sessions.
- THE DISTRICT CHAIRMAN IS ADDRESSED ONLY AS DISTRICT
 CHAIRMAN not DISTRICT CHAIRPERSON

In Salutations / In Addressing Dignitaries

District Chairman is the CEO of the District

- Current National & District Officers, if any
- Future Officers, if any
- Past District Chairmen
- Other Dignitaries
- Club Presidents & Members

- And to be addressed before acknowledging Rotary Dignitaries/ Guests
